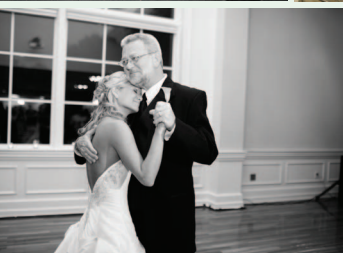


**Q:** Why did you choose your photographer?
