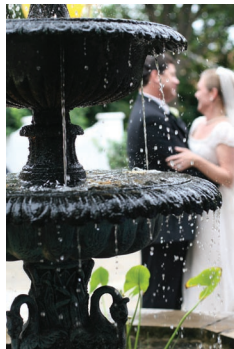


# julia crews & bradley wilkinson
